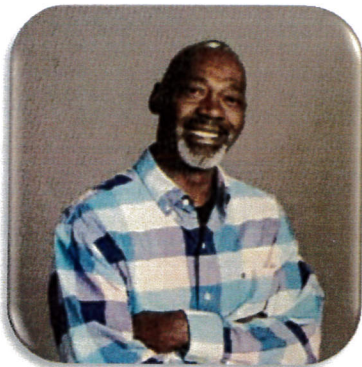
Janice Bishop (Submitted by Daughter Tonya Bishop Gable)
